You Are Worth Melting For

Romans 5:8-9 NKJV

8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Olaf is a great little friend. Being a great friend doesn't make him the smartest by any stretch of the imagination. He realized that Anna was in trouble. Unlike him, she couldn't freeze so he made her a fire something any other self-respecting snowman would know to stay away from. But Olaf realized that Anna was so important to him that he was willing to melt for her. That is a friend.

Paul, the guy who wrote Romans tells us about a friend we have. Someone that was willing not to just melt for us, but to give us something even better ... His life. Jesus did that before we even knew who He was. Imagine a friend that does something for you before you realize he is your friend. How would you feel about someone like that? Paul tells us that is how God demonstrates how much He loves us; Christ died for us. That part you know, but did you know that He did it before we even knew He was our friend?! That while we were still sinners, that means doing things we know we aren't suppose to be doing, Jesus laid down His life for us.

Jesus Loves You

Yea you have sung the song in church but did you know that Jesus really does love you? As a kid, you are important to Jesus too. It wasn't just for adults.

Mark 10:13-16 NKJV

Then they brought little children to Him, that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought them.14 But when Jesus saw

You're not here by accident. God loves you. He loves you so much that He sent His son Jesus to pay for the things you have done wrong – for your sins. That's what separates us from God, sin. But you are so important to God that He sent His very best to save you because He wants you to have a personal relationship with Him through Jesus, His Son. It is very easy to have a relationship with Jesus; in fact it is just like your ABCs.

Admit

Admit to God that you are a sinner. Each of us has a problem the Bible calls sin. "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Rom. 3:23). Since none of us is perfect, all of us are sinners (Rom. 3:10- 18).

Believe

Believe in Jesus Christ as God's Son and receive Jesus' gift of forgiveness from sin. God loves each of us. God offers us salvation. Although we have done nothing to deserve His love and salvation, God wants to save us. In the death of Jesus on the cross, God provided salvation for all who would repent of their sins and believe in Jesus. "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16).

Confess

Confess your faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord to others. After you have received Jesus Christ into your life, share your decision with another person. Tell your pastor or a Christian friend about your decision. Following Christ's example, ask for baptism by immersion in your local church as a public expression of your faith. "If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved" (Rom. 10:9-10).

it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God.15 Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it."16 And He took them up in His arms, laid His hands on them, and blessed them

People were bringing their children to Jesus to bless but His disciples didn't want them (they rebuked them) but Jesus didn't put up with that. Instead He told them and the people how important children were to the Kingdom of God. As a matter of fact, you can't get into heaven without faith like a child meaning you love unconditionally – you don't love someone because they do something for you.

Jesus Finds Us When We Are Lost

Jesus thinks you are so important that He comes looking for you when you are lost. Like Anna searching for Elsa, Jesus is always trying to find us when we aren't doing what we are suppose to do.

Matthew 18:12-13 NKJV

12 "What do you think? If a man has a hundred sheep, and one of them goes astray, does he not leave the ninety-nine and go to the mountains to seek the one that is straying? 13 And if he should find it, assuredly, I say to you, he rejoices more over that sheep than over the ninety-nine that did not go astray

You and me, we are the sheep who get lost and the shepherd (Jesus) leaves the ones that are safe and searches for us. Jesus tells us that not only does He come find us, but that He rejoices (is really happy and throws a celebration party) when He finds us and brings us back. That is pretty incredible.

Jesus Sees How Valuable You Are

You may not think you are important, people around you may not think you are important but Jesus says you are important. Not only are you important to Him but also you are important to God. How so?

Matt 6:26-27 NKJV

26 Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?

Birds don't prepare anything for a long winter; they find their food everyday. Jesus sees when just one of them falls to the ground. How much more important are you? A lot more important! He loves you so much He gave His life for you. Doesn't get much better than that.

Maybe you didn't know it, but Jesus says you are worth melting for – He gave His life for you and me.
